The seminar was organized by the RC 48 – Administrative Culture (the IPSA) and RC on comparative politics (the Russian Political Science Association). The book reviews the essence of axiological turn in theory and practice of public governance, the concept of values, public value management, and the mechanisms for determining the public values in public and municipal administration. Particular attention is paid to the influence of the axiological approach to the civil service. The book was written on material on Russia and foreign countries.
